1. ORDINANCE NO. 10-32 - INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL – AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIAL TO EXPEND REVOLVING LOAN FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

2. ORDINANCE NO. 10-33 - INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL – AN ORDINANCE TERMINATING AN ENTERPRISE ZONE AGREEMENT WITH WORTHINGTON FOODS, INC. AND REQUESTING THE MUSKINGUM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO APPROVE THE SAME.

E. ORDINANCES FOR ACTION

3. ORDINANCE NO. 10-28 – INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL – AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 07-114, 07-115, 09-01, 09-02, 09-11, 09-32, 09-37, AND 10-12, WHICH ESTABLISHED PAY, BENEFIT, AND EMPLOYMENT POLICIES FOR EMPLOYEES IN THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE. (SECOND READING)

4. ORDINANCE NO. 10-30 – INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL – AUTHORIZING HE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$1,210,000 OF BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPAIRING AND IMPROVING THE STATE STREET BRIDGE, CONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING AND OTHERWISE ENHANCING SIXTH STREET; AUTHORIZING A BOND PURCHASE AGREEMENT APPROPRIATE FOR THE SALE OF THE BONDS; AUTHORIZING AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALE OF THE BONDS; AND RETIRING NOTES PREVIOUSLY ISSUED FOR SUCH PURPOSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

5. ORDINANCE NO. 10-31 – INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL – AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$65,000 OF GENERAL OBLIGATION LIMITED TAX BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTING, AND INSTALLING IMPROVEMENTS TO SECREST AUDITORIUM; AUTHORIZING A BOND PURCHASE AGREEMENT APPROPRIATE FOR THE SALE OF THE BONDS; AUTHORIZING THE USE AND DELIVERY OF AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT RELATING TO THE BONDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

6. ORDINANCE NO. 10-24 – INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL – AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 97-127, AS AMENDED, WHICH AUTHORIZED A MAXIMUM SCHEDULE OF POSITIONS, AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF SICK LEAVE RECIPROCITY BENEFITS. (THIRD READING)
